violence, one in five in a serious relationship have reported being slapped, pushed, hit, threatened or coerced by their partner, and breakups are a time of greater risk,

even when a relationship was never physically abusive; and

Whereas: Young people can choose better relationships when they understand that healthy

relationships are based on respect and learn to identify early warning signs of an

abusive relationship; and

Whereas: Elimination of dating violence must be achieved through cooperation of

individuals, organizations and communities; and

Whereas: Dating Violence Awareness Month provides an excellent opportunity for citizens

to learn more about preventing dating violence and to show support for the numerous organizations and individuals who provide critical advocacy, services

and assistance to victims:
