In Recognition of

Dating Violence Awareness Prevention Month

OFHEREAS, dating violence is a reality for many young people, and an issue that many are unaware of; and

OFHEREAS, 1 in 3 young people are affected by physical, sexual or verbal dating violence, with 1 in 5 in a serious relationship reporting having been slapped, pushed, hit, threatened or coerced by a partner, and breakups can be a time of even greater risk even when a relationship was never physically abusive; and

OFHEREAS, young people can choose better relationships when they understand that healthy relationships are based on respect and learn to identify early warning signs of an abusive relationship; and

OFHEREAS, elimination of dating violence must be achieved through cooperation of individuals, organizations, and communities; and

OFHEREAS, Dating Violence Awareness & Prevention Month provides an excellent opportunity for citizens to learn more about preventing dating violence and to show support for the numerous organizations and individuals who provide critical advocacy, services and assistance to victims.
