

PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS, dating violence is a reality for many young people, and an issue that many are unaware of; and
- WHEREAS, one in three young people are affected by physical, sexual, or verbal dating violence and one in five are in a serious relationship reporting having been slapped, pushed, hit, threatened or coerced by a partner. Breakups can be a time of even greater risk, even when a relationship was never physically abusive; and
- WHEREAS, when young people understand that healthy relationships are based on respect and learn to identify early warning signs of an abusive relationship, they will choose better relationships; and
- WHEREAS, elimination of dating violence must be achieved through cooperation of individuals, organizations, and communities; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Timothy P. Dougherty, Mayor of the Town of Morristown, on behalf of all the citizens do hereby proclaim February 2010 as
