- WHEREAS, 60% of the students surveyed in 2009 reported they knew a female victim of dating violence; and
- WHEREAS, this survey of local middle and high school students indicates that students victimized at a young age tend to be victimized repeatedly; and
- WHEREAS, Teen Dating Violence Prevention Month is an opportunity for parents, teens, educators, program providers, and local elected leaders to work together to reduce and prevent teen pregnancy in Chesterfield County.
