WHERAS, dating violence is a reality for many youth, and an issue that many are unaware of; and

WHERAS, one in three young people in the United States is a victim of physical, emotional, or verbal abuse from a dating partner, with one in five in a serious relationship reporting having been slapped, pushed, hit, threatened or coerced by a partner; and breakups can be a time of even greater risk even when a relationship was never physically abusive; and

WHERAS, young people can choose better relationships when they understand that healthy relationships are based on respect and learn to identify early warning signs of an abusive relationship; and

WHERAS, eliminating of dating violence must be achieved through cooperation of individuals, organizations, and communities; and

WHERAS, the establishment of Dating Violence Awareness and Prevention Month will benefit teens, their families, schools, and communities regardless of socioeconomic status, ethnicity, or gender;
